### 9.3 Manage monthly patching service

Before applying the monthly patches to the database, ensure that the data import services are not running on the database. To verify this, run the following commands on the “unosm-r-app-01”:

```
systemctl status imposm_upd_osm_planet.service
```

```
systemctl status imposm_upd_osm_planet_buildings.service
```

If the log is frozen for a few minutes, it means the services have stopped writing to the database. Check the number of diffs applied and the time it took to apply them. In this case, you're ready to apply the patches to the server/database. As usual, we recommend to stop the database on the slave nodes and then apply the OS patches on the nodes, and finally restarting the master node and then (once the master node is up and running) the slave nodes.
